Dear Chairman Wolf and Ranking Member Fattah:

Thank you for your strong support in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2013 Commerce, Justice, Science, and Related Agencies Appropriations for the Hollings Manufacturing Extension Partnership (MEP) program. We are writing to express our support for MEP as you develop the FY2014 bill and urge providing sustained, level funding.

Manufacturing is one of our country's greatest economic strengths, and demand for MEP services is greater than ever. Existing MEP centers are in need of these scarce funds to provide critical resources, serve new and existing clients, and create job growth. As a **public-private partnership**, MEP helps leverage funds in government, business, and academia to augment current state and local activities and industrial efforts and ensure that the federal government is not shouldering the full financial burden for the MEP program.

These federal funds, **provided on a competitive basis to nonprofit, state, or local organizations**, support a nationwide network of 60 centers and additional field offices. Centers are located in every state and provide a variety of services from innovation strategies to process improvements, all aiding efforts to increase productivity, expand economic growth, and foster job creation in our communities through smart technical, scientific, or managerial assistance to small- and medium-sized U.S. manufacturers with fewer than 500 employees. After six years, federal funding may be provided at no more than one-third of these costs if the center has received a positive, independent evaluation, thus providing built-in program accountability.


For twenty years, Congress has consistently recognized the importance of MEP for our manufacturing base. Moreover, MEP delivers a high return on investment to taxpayers. According to data from the National Institute of Standards and Technology, **for every one dollar of federal investment, MEP generates nearly \$20 in new sales growth** and \$20 in new client investment. This translates into \$2.5 billion in new sales annually.

We must continue to support the success of this program and innovation-sharing developed through research at federal laboratories, educational institutions, and corporations to help bring this knowledge to the hands of U.S. manufacturers. By doing so, MEP provides technical expertise to our U.S. manufacturing base, leading to higher tax receipts and new jobs in the advanced manufacturing sector. According to the American Small Manufacturers Coalition, small and medium-sized manufacturers employ 9 million workers in the U.S., and in **FY2012**


alone (based on services provided in 2011), MEP projects with small- and medium-sized manufacturers created or retained 61,139 jobs, generated more than \$2.5 billion in new sales, and provided cost-savings of more than \$900 million.

We believe MEP continues to be a wise investment. We respectfully request providing level funding to and through the existing MEP center network in FY2014.


