Other notable provisions:

Though the Committee noted the HOME Investment Partnerships Program's great success in helping extremely low-income families, no explanation is provided for the \$994 million decrease from FY2015.

Marine highway infrastructure – funding includes \$5 million to the Maritime Administration for Marine Highway Grants (Short Sea Shipping)

- Funding requested for a national pipeline safety exchange under Pipeline Safety is not provided
- Language requires a report analyzing the comparative safety of shipping oil by rail, pipeline, or truck within 90 days.
- Language also requires reporting on recent studies using U.S. Geological Survey data to monitor for potential spills during flood events.
- Additionally, an amendment from Sen. Patty Murray (D-WA) directed PHMSA to initiate a rulemaking expanding the applicability of comprehensive oil spill response plans to rail carriers.
